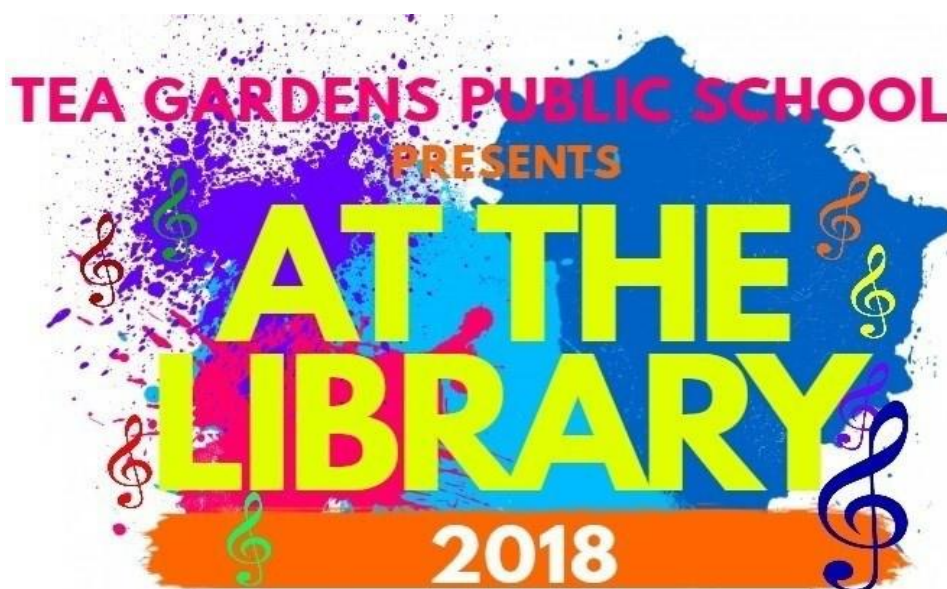
### Circular Circus

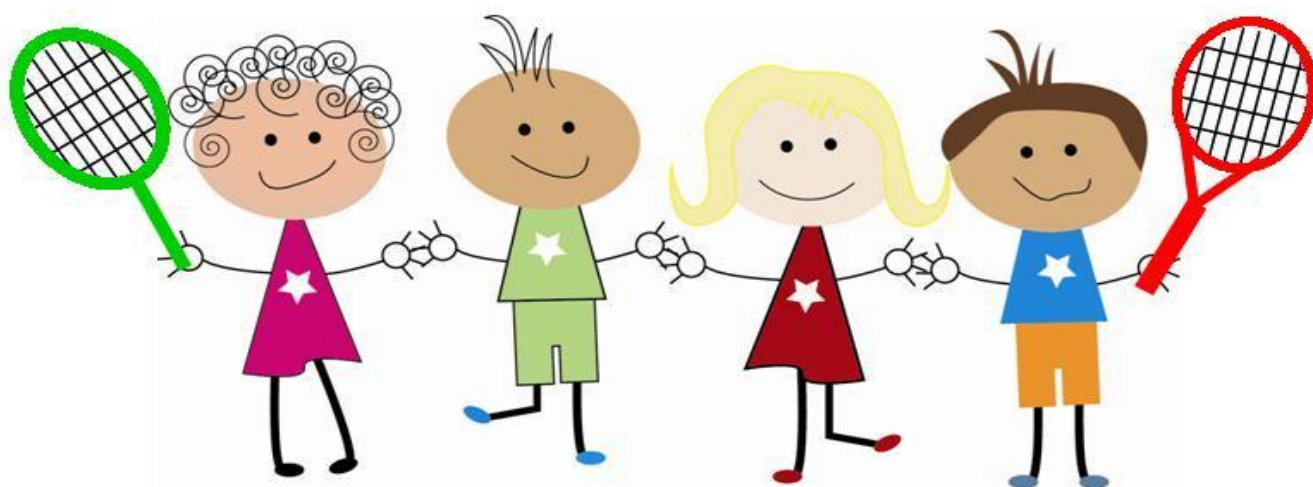
