Managing Mosquito Infestations

The recent rain has seen an increase in the prevalence of mosquitoes in many areas across NSW including here in Tea Gardens. Mosquito bites are unpleasant and, in some circumstances can transmit disease such as Ross River Fever. Please consider the following simple steps that can be taken to protect against mosquitoes:

- covering up when outside
- applying mosquito repellent to exposed skin
- using appropriate insecticides where required

• removing potential breeding sites by ensuring there is no containers with water laying around the school.

What do I do if you receive a letter about unexplained absences in the mail?

Please complete the details on the second page and return this to your child's teacher at school so they can update the class attendance records accordingly. The Education Act 1990 requires a parent / carer to explain your child's absence within seven days. Failure to do so will result in an unjustified absence being recorded.

Speech Screening and Assessments

In term 4, 2020, with parental consent, 81 students including most of our current Kindy cohort were screened for speech in the areas of articulation, expressive and receptive language.

As part of our Strategic Improvement Plan, 2021-2024, we have engaged a speech pathologist to support our school each week and provide ongoing therapy for students requiring additional support in the early learning years of schooling.

New consent forms have been sent home to any child in Kindergarten to Year 2 who were not screened last year. Having this screener information will allow us to be able to accurately allocate students into therapy groups. Weekly speech sessions will commence after the screening is completed early in term 2. If you've received a form, we'd appreciate if you could complete the form and return to the office.
